The Old Upper City of Bergamo has very limited parking spaces. It is advisable to park in the center of the lower city and either take a taxi or Bus N° 1 and get off at the cable railway. With the same ticket take the cable railway which arrives at the square where the Library is located. Should you arrive by train, it is possible to take Bus N° 1 directly at the station and then proceed with the cable railway.

Hotel reservations are to be handled individually using the usual internet websites. The Hotels and B&Bs of the Upper City are close to the Library and hotel guests have permission to park in the Upper City (check hotels for further information).
